

VOLUNTEERING OPTIONS



Unpaid professionals; trained, skilled and bringing their experience to search and rescue.

Option 1: Field Team Member

Alerted to a search by text to your personal mobile phone, you will be deployed in a team to a variety of terrain. The weather could be good, bad or indifferent. The time, day or night. You will be set tasks by a management team and need to report on progress and findings.

FIELD TEAM MEMBER



Deployed in urban and wilderness areas
Deployment could be 8 - 72 hours
Will be self sufficient in bush including;
sleeping and cooking.

SUBURBAN FIELD TEAM MEMBER



Only deployed in urban or suburban areas
Deployment can be up to 10 hours
Not expected to sleep out overnight,
but likely to search overnight.

Option 2: Incident Management Teams - IMT

The IMT is responsible for developing the response, planning and managing the search. This includes gathering information and developing intelligence to give the field teams the greatest possible chance of success. This team is lead by the police and your fit into it may be in management or support role. You work from the SAR operation headquarters, located in Lower Hutt.



Option 3: Support Crew

This is an administration and logistics support team that is NON-Operational. You assist behind the scenes with ensuring support is provided to the group.
